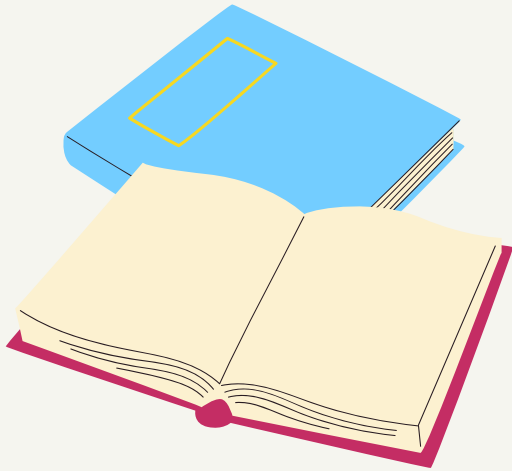


# E X A M I N E NURSING



## REGISTERED NURSE

**What they do:** Assess patient health problems and needs, develop and carry out nursing care plans, and maintain medical records. Administer nursing care to ill, injured, or disabled patients.

**How to get there:** Generally requires a bachelor's degree

**What they make:** \$29.32/hour



## NURSING ASSISTANT

**What they do:** Provide or assist with basic care under the direction of onsite licensed nursing staff. Perform duties such as monitoring of health status, feeding, bathing and dressing in a health or nursing facility.

**How to get there:** Generally requires a post-secondary certificate

**What they make:** \$15.31/hour

## NURSE PRACTITIONER

**What they do:** Diagnose and treat patients, independently or as part of a healthcare team. They can also focus on wellness or disease prevention. May order, perform, or interpret tests like lab work and x rays.

**How to get there:** Requires a master's degree.

**What they make:** \$48.96/hour



## LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE

**What they do:** Care for ill, injured, or recovering patients in hospitals, nursing homes, clinics, private homes, group homes and similar institutions

**How to get there:** Requires a post-secondary certificate or associate's degree

**What they make:** \$22.26/hour
