

# EXPLORE WAREHOUSING



#### SHIFT OPERATIONS MANAGER

What they do: Plan, direct, or coordinate transportation, storage, or distribution activities. They also act in a leadership role for workers on shift, and monitor inventory, quality, and other aspects of supply chain management.

How to get there: Generally requires a bachelor's degree What they make: \$32.53/hour



## **MATERIAL HANDLER**

What they do: Work to move freight, stock, luggage, or other materials, or perform other tasks in a warehouse or logistics environment.

# **OPERATIONS MANAGER**

What they do: Operations Manager are usually responsible for the warehouse facility as a whole, including overseeing decisions and processes that make the facility work efficiently and safely. How to get there: Requires a master's degree.

What they make: \$41.61/hour



## DISTRIBUTION SUPERVISOR

What they do: Distribution Supervisors directly supervise and coordinate the work of material movers, helpers, and laborers within a logistics environment. How to get there: Requires a postsecondary certificate or associate's degree What they make: \$29.05/hour



How to get there: Requires a high school diploma or less. What they make: \$14.58/hour
