

INVESTIGATE INDUSTRIAL MAINTENANCE

IND. MAINTENANCE PLANNER

What they do: Develop plans for installing, repairing, dismantling, or moving industrial machinery and heavy equipment.

How to get there: Often requires a postsecondary certificate or associate's degree.

What they make: \$29.66/hour



MAINTENANCE/REPAIR WORKER

What they do: Perform work to keep machines, mechanical equipment, or the structure of a building in repair.

How to get there: Generally requires a high school diploma

What they make: \$19.34/hour

IND. MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR

What they do: Directly supervise and coordinate the activities of mechanics, installers, and repairers.

How to get there: Typically requires a postsecondary certificate, associate's degree and/or on-the-job experience.

What they make: \$35.11/hour



INDUSTRIAL MACHINERY MECHANIC

What they do: Repair, install, adjust, or maintain industrial production and processing machinery or refinery and pipeline distribution systems.

How to get there: Often requires a post-secondary certificate

What they make: \$26.04/hour
