WHAT IS HEALTHCARE AND SOCIAL ASSISTANCE?

The Healthcare and Social Assistance sector comprises establishments providing health care and social assistance for individuals. The sector includes both health care and social assistance because it is sometimes difficult to distinguish between the boundaries of these two activities. The services provided are delivered by trained professionals.

Industries in the Hospitals subsector provide medical, diagnostic, and treatment services including physician, nursing, and other health services to inpatients. Establishments in the Hospitals subsector provide many services which can only be provided using the specialized facilities and equipment.

The Nursing and Residential Care Facilities subsector provides residential care combined with nursing or other types of care as required by the residents.
